

## Detailed Saleyard Report - Sheep and Lamb

Lamb numbers increased and quality was good for the better trade and heavy weight lambs that were well presented, along with some plainer lines throughout. There were mainly trade lambs penned, along with some heavy and extra heavy weights, and a few stores were offered. All the buyers were present and operating and competition was strong resulting in prices continuing there dearer trend.

Light lambs to the processors were \$7 dearer and averaged \$134, while stores averaged from \$103 to \$150/head. Medium and heavy trade weight lambs were \$5/head dearer and averaged from 730c to 735c/kg cwt. Most of the heavy trade weight to 22kg sold from \$159 to \$168, while the 23-24kg sold from \$171 to \$181/head. Heavy weight lambs were \$4 to \$8/head stronger and averaged from 675c to 720c/kg cwt. A few pens of extra heavy weight lambs made from \$180 to \$212 and topped at \$230/head.

Mutton numbers increased and quality was varied throughout, with prices gaining \$8 to \$15/head. Medium Merino wethers sold from \$114 to \$164/head or 550c to 570c/kg cwt. Heavy first cross ewes received from \$144 to \$201/head or 580c/kg cwt.
